It is important to have a management plan in place to ensure that future use or developments preserve and respect the heritage, environment, and cultural significance of the site. You are welcome to enjoy this beautiful hot spring on the condition that you respect the practices.

BUSY MONTHS

Busy months are between May & September. During those months, we suggest booking a week in advance to ensure a pleasant visit. In slower months we require at least 24 hours notice.

STANDARD POLICIES

 Recreational drugs and alcohol are prohibited from the site and parking lot.

- If you are consuming these substances you will be asked to leave. You will not be eligible for a refund if you are asked to leave for these reasons.
- Pets are welcome in the parking lot but we request that you not bring them beyond the fence. As a sacred site, this is like bringing your dog inside a church.
 We also ask that you pick up after your dog.
- Respect this special place by packing out garbage and depositing it into the bins we have provided.
- Overnight camping or parking is prohibited.
- Fires are prohibited.
- Failure to comply with these policies may result in your expulsion and/or ban.
