A message from the President of Nisga'a Nation & Nisga'a Nation 2nd Virtual Open House (January 26th)

As many of you may recall, last summer the Ksi Lisims LNG Project, a joint initiative between the Nisga'a Nation and our partners officially kicked off the environmental assessment process with the British Columbia Environmental Assessment Office. It is the first step in a comprehensive review of the potential impacts; both positive and negative, and of the various ways they can be avoided or mitigated.

Early and ongoing engagement with those potentially impacted is important to ensure projects are designed in ways that limits footprint and impacts. As an early opportunity for Nisga'a Citizens, we organized a dedicated Virtual Open House for Nisga'a Citizens in early Fall, which I am happy to report was very well attended. There were also two additional public open houses organized by the BC Environmental Assessment Office. There will be many more similar opportunities as this process takes a number of years to complete.

Nisga'a Nation Executive and NLG officials continue to work diligently to ensure these early stages of development are being undertaken in a manner consistent with Chapter 10 of the Nisga'a Final Agreement where appropriate and consider the various interests our Nation, Communities and Citizens hold dear.

During 2022 we will have many more opportunities to continue to learn more about this project and the results of some of the studies and assessments that are already underway. Due to the ongoing Covid-19 pandemic, we are forced to continue delaying in-person Community Open Houses but please rest assured that as soon as it is safe to do so, we will visit every Nisga'a Village and Urban Local to provide opportunities to each of you to ask questions and provide feedback.

In the meantime, we are planning on hosting another Virtual Open House for Nisga'a Citizens on January 26th at 6:30 PM. Stay tuned for more information as that date approaches.

We will continue to provide regular updates as information becomes available at every stage of this process.

Myself and the rest of the Executive continue to keep a close eye on all of the work and progress being made on this initiative. We remain as committed as ever to ensure any development in the Nass Area is done in a way that respects our environment, our values, and our culture while also providing opportunities to our people and the Nation.

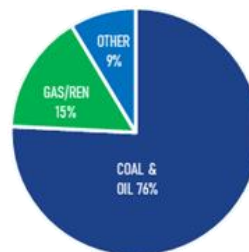
ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY
