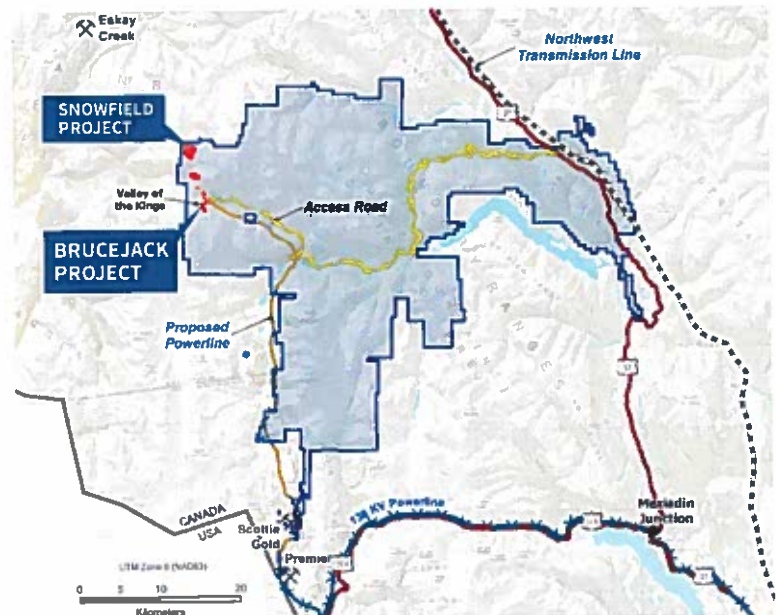




BRUCEJACK PROJECT

Commercial production is targeted for 2017 for the high-grade underground Brucejack Gold Project. The Project is now fully funded, fully permitted and construction is well under way. Located in northwestern British Columbia, approximately 65 kilometers north of Stewart, BC the property consists of 122,096 hectares (over 301,705 acres).

The Project will employ 900 employees and contractors during the peak of the 24 month construction period. Once in operation the mine will employ approximately 500 people throughout the expected 18 year mine life.
