NISGA’A GOVERNMENT REGULATION

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PART 1 – DEFINITIONS

Definitions

1. The words and expressions defined in section 1 of the *Nisga'a Government Act* have the same meanings in this Regulation.

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PART 2 – REGISTRY OF NISGA'A LAWS**Office of Nisga'a Lisims Government**

2. On any terms and conditions set by the Law Clerk, a person may apply in person at the principal administrative office of Nisga'a Lisims Government
 - (a) to inspect, or
 - (b) to obtain copies ofNisga'a enactments and other documents deposited in the registry.

Distribution of registered documents

3. As soon as practicable after depositing a Nisga'a enactment or other document in the registry, the Law Clerk must deliver a certified copy of that Nisga'a enactment or other document to
 - (a) each Nisga'a Village Government, at the principal administrative office of the Nisga'a Village Government, and
 - (b) each Nisga'a Urban Local Office.

Offices of Nisga'a Village Governments

4. On any terms and conditions set by the Chief Administrator of a Nisga'a Village Government, a person may apply at the principal administrative office of that Nisga'a Village Government
 - (a) to inspect, or
 - (b) to obtain copies of

Nisga'a enactments and other documents delivered to the Nisga'a Village Government under section 3.

Offices of Nisga'a Urban Locals

5. On any terms and conditions set by the Nisga'a Urban Local Executive member elected from a Nisga'a Urban Local Area, a person may apply at a Nisga'a Urban Local Office located within the Nisga'a Urban Local Area
 - (a) to inspect, or

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(b) to obtain copies of
Nisga'a enactments and other documents delivered to the Nisga'a Urban Local Office under section 3.

Fees

6. (1) No fee is payable to inspect Nisga'a enactments or other documents on an application under section 2(a), 4(a) or 5(a).
- (2) A fee of \$0.25 per page is payable for copies of Nisga'a enactments or other documents obtained on an application under section 2(b), 4(b) or 5(b).

Registry seal

7. The symbol set out in Schedule A to this Regulation is prescribed as the seal of the registry and is entrusted to the care of the Chairperson.

Certification

8. The Law Clerk may certify a copy of a Nisga'a enactment or other document as a true copy of the original deposited in the registry.

PART 3 – MEMBERS' CODE OF CONDUCT

Additional definitions in Part 3 and Schedule B

9. (1) In this Part and Schedule B:

“business” means an activity carried on or an undertaking operated for the purpose of gain or profit;

“criminal proceedings disclosure form” means Form 3 in Schedule B;

“disclosable land interest” means

- (a) an interest in a parcel of land within Nisga'a Lands, or
- (b) an interest in a parcel of land outside Nisga'a Lands that is reasonably likely to be materially affected by a decision of Nisga'a Government or a Nisga'a governmental body;

“disclosable private business interest” means a direct or indirect interest, other than the interest of an employee, in a private business;

“disclosable public business interest” means a direct interest, other than the interest of an employee, in a public business that is reasonably likely to be materially affected by a decision of Nisga'a Government or a Nisga'a governmental body;

“disclosable trust property” means trust property that includes a disclosable land interest, a disclosable private business interest or a disclosable public business interest;

“disclosure form inspection request form” means Form 4 in Schedule B;

“employer” means a person from whom another person receives payment for performing work or providing services as an employee and, in the case of a Nisga'a representative, does not include the Nisga'a Nation, a Nisga'a Village, or a Nisga'a Urban Local Society;

“general disclosure form” means Form 1 in Schedule B;

“gift disclosure form” means Form 2 in Schedule B;

“private business” means any business, however structured, other than a public business;

“public business” means a corporation whose securities are traded publicly on a securities exchange recognized by the securities regulatory authority in the jurisdiction in

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which the exchange operates;

“trust property” means property of any kind that is held by a trustee in a trust arrangement for the benefit of another person.

- (2) The words and expressions defined in section 1 of the Code have the same meanings in this Part and Schedule B.

Confidential documents

10. (1) When preparing a document for distribution before or at a meeting, a chief administrator may identify that document as requiring secure handling and destruction by marking on the first page of the document the word “PROTECTED” or the word “CONFIDENTIAL”.
- (2) A Nisga’a representative who at a meeting receives a document marked “PROTECTED” by a chief administrator under subsection (1)
- (a) must not make any copy of that document, and
 - (b) must not show the document to any person other than another Nisga’a representative who attended or was entitled to attend that meeting.
- (3) A Nisga’a representative who at a meeting receives a document marked “CONFIDENTIAL” by a chief administrator under subsection (1)
- (a) must not make any copy of that document,
 - (b) must not show the document to any person other than another Nisga’a representative attending that meeting, and
 - (c) must return the document to that chief administrator at the conclusion of the meeting.

Prescribed forms

11. The forms in Schedule B are prescribed for the purposes of the Code and must be used as applicable.

General disclosure form

12. (1) A Nisga'a representative must accurately complete and file a general disclosure form with the Reporting Officer within 30 days after
- (a) that Nisga'a representative is first elected or appointed to their office,
 - (b) a change in the circumstances of the Nisga'a representative occurs, as described in subsection (3), and
 - (c) the second anniversary of the date on which the Nisga'a representative last filed a general disclosure form.
- (2) Subsection (1)(a) does not apply to a Nisga'a Representative if that Nisga'a representative has completed and filed with the Reporting Officer a general disclosure form during the two-year period before the Nisga'a representative is first elected or appointed to their office.
- (3) For the purposes of subsection (1)(b), a change in the circumstances of a Nisga'a representative occurs if that Nisga'a representative or the spouse of the Nisga'a representative
- (a) becomes employed by an employer who was not disclosed in the general disclosure form last filed by the Nisga'a representative,
 - (b) assumes a position as an officer or director of a private business or a public business that was not disclosed in the general disclosure form last filed by the Nisga'a representative,
 - (c) acquires a disclosable land interest that was not disclosed in the general disclosure form last filed by the Nisga'a representative,
 - (d) holds an interest in a parcel of land outside Nisga'a Lands that was not disclosed in the general disclosure form last filed by the Nisga'a representative, and an event occurs that makes that interest a disclosable land interest,
 - (e) acquires a disclosable private business interest that was not disclosed in the general disclosure form last filed by the Nisga'a representative,
 - (f) acquires a disclosable public business interest that was not disclosed in the general disclosure form last filed by the Nisga'a representative,
 - (g) holds an interest in a public business that was not disclosed in the general disclosure form last filed by the Nisga'a representative, and an event occurs that makes that interest a disclosable public business interest,

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- (h) acquires a beneficial interest in disclosable trust property that was not disclosed in the general disclosure form last filed by the Nisga'a representative, or
- (i) has a beneficial interest in trust property that was not disclosed in the general disclosure form last filed by the Nisga'a representative, and an event occurs that makes that trust property disclosable trust property.

Retention of disclosure forms

- 13.** (1) The Reporting Officer must keep on file each general disclosure form filed with the Reporting Officer by a Nisga'a representative under the Code and this Regulation until the earliest of
- (a) the date on which that Nisga'a representative files a subsequent general disclosure form, or
 - (b) two years after the date on which
 - (i) the Nisga'a representative's term of office expires, or
 - (ii) the Nisga'a representative resigns from or otherwise ceases to hold their office, if the Nisga'a representative resigns from or otherwise ceases to hold their office before the expiry of their term of office.
- (2) The Reporting Officer must keep on file each gift disclosure form filed with the Reporting Officer by a Nisga'a representative under the Code and this Regulation until the earlier of two years after the date on which
- (a) that Nisga'a representative's term of office expires, or
 - (b) the Nisga'a representative resigns from or otherwise ceases to hold their office, if the Nisga'a representative resigns from or otherwise ceases to hold their office before the expiry of their term of office.
- (3) The Reporting Officer must keep on file each criminal proceedings disclosure form filed with the Reporting Officer by a Nisga'a representative under the Code and this Regulation until the earliest of
- (a) the date on which that Nisga'a representative is finally acquitted of the criminal charge concerned, or
 - (b) two years after the date on which
 - (i) the Nisga'a representative's term of office expires, or

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-
- (ii) the Nisga'a representative resigns from or otherwise ceases to hold their office, if the Nisga'a representative resigns from or otherwise ceases to hold their office before the expiry of their term of office.
- (4) For the purposes of subsection (3)(a), a Nisga'a representative is finally acquitted of a criminal charge when that Nisga'a representative is acquitted of that charge, and
- (a) all periods for appeal of that acquittal have expired, or
 - (b) the acquittal has been upheld on appeal, and no further appeal is available.

Inspection of disclosure forms

14. (1) On any terms and conditions set by the Reporting Officer, a Nisga'a citizen may apply to inspect the general disclosure forms and any gift disclosure forms or criminal proceedings disclosure forms filed by a Nisga'a representative with the Reporting Officer and kept on file by the Reporting Officer under the Code and this Regulation
- (a) by attending in person at the principal administrative office of Nisga'a Lisims Government, and
 - (b) by completing and submitting to the Reporting Officer a disclosure form inspection request form.
- (2) For each Nisga'a representative whose disclosure forms a Nisga'a citizen applies to inspect under subsection (1), the Nisga'a citizen must
- (a) complete and submit to the Reporting Officer a separate disclosure form inspection request form, and
 - (b) pay a fee of \$10.

“public business” means a corporation whose securities are traded publicly on a securities exchange recognized by the securities regulatory authority in the jurisdiction in which the exchange operates;

“spouse” means a person who

- (a) is married to another person, or
- (b) is, and has been for at least one year, living in a marriage-like relationship with another person;

“trust property” means property of any kind that is held by a trustee in a trust arrangement for the benefit of another person.
