

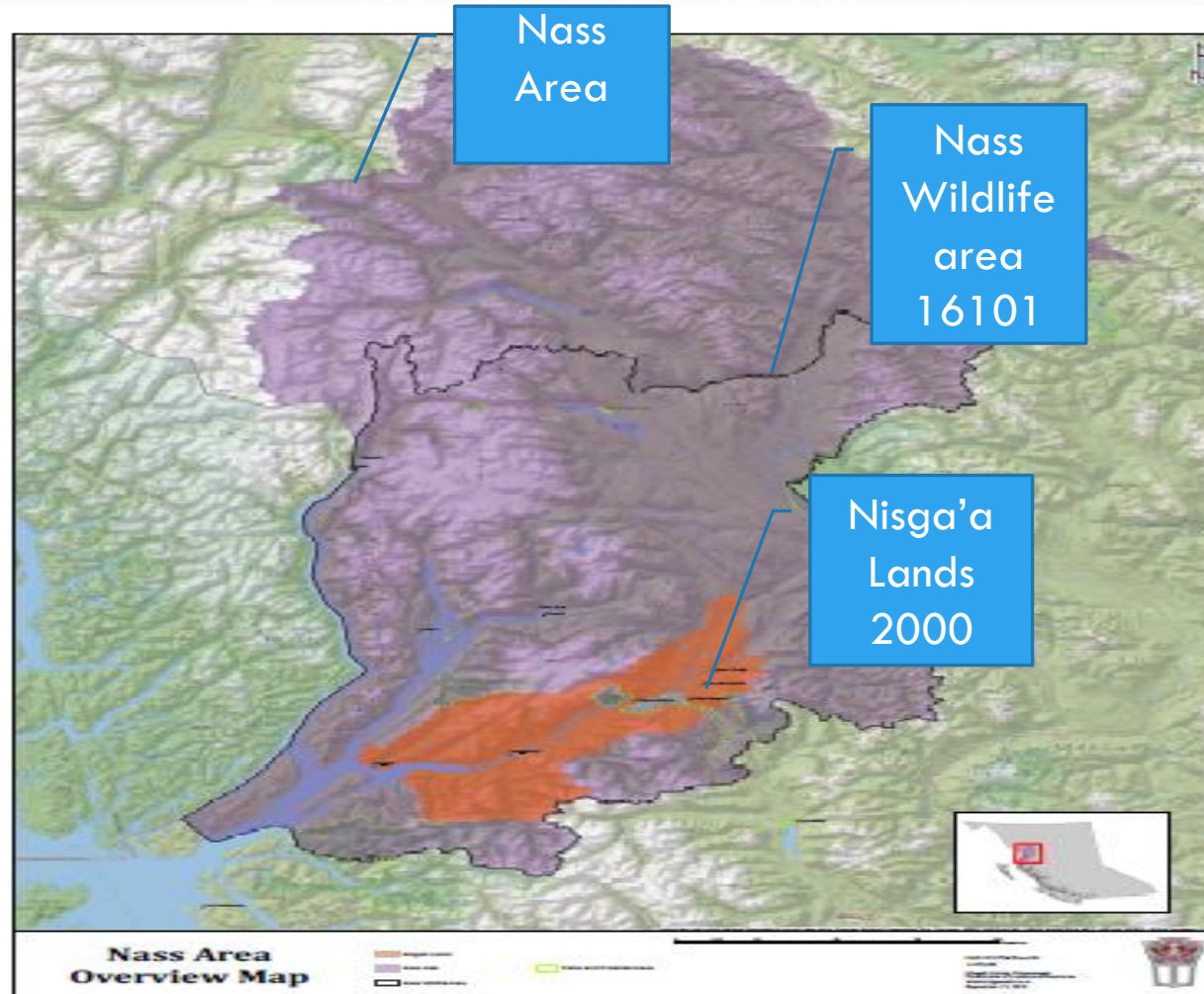
WHAT DOES THE NISGA'A LISIMS GOVERNMENT COMPLIANCE & ENFORCEMENT DEPARTMENT DO?

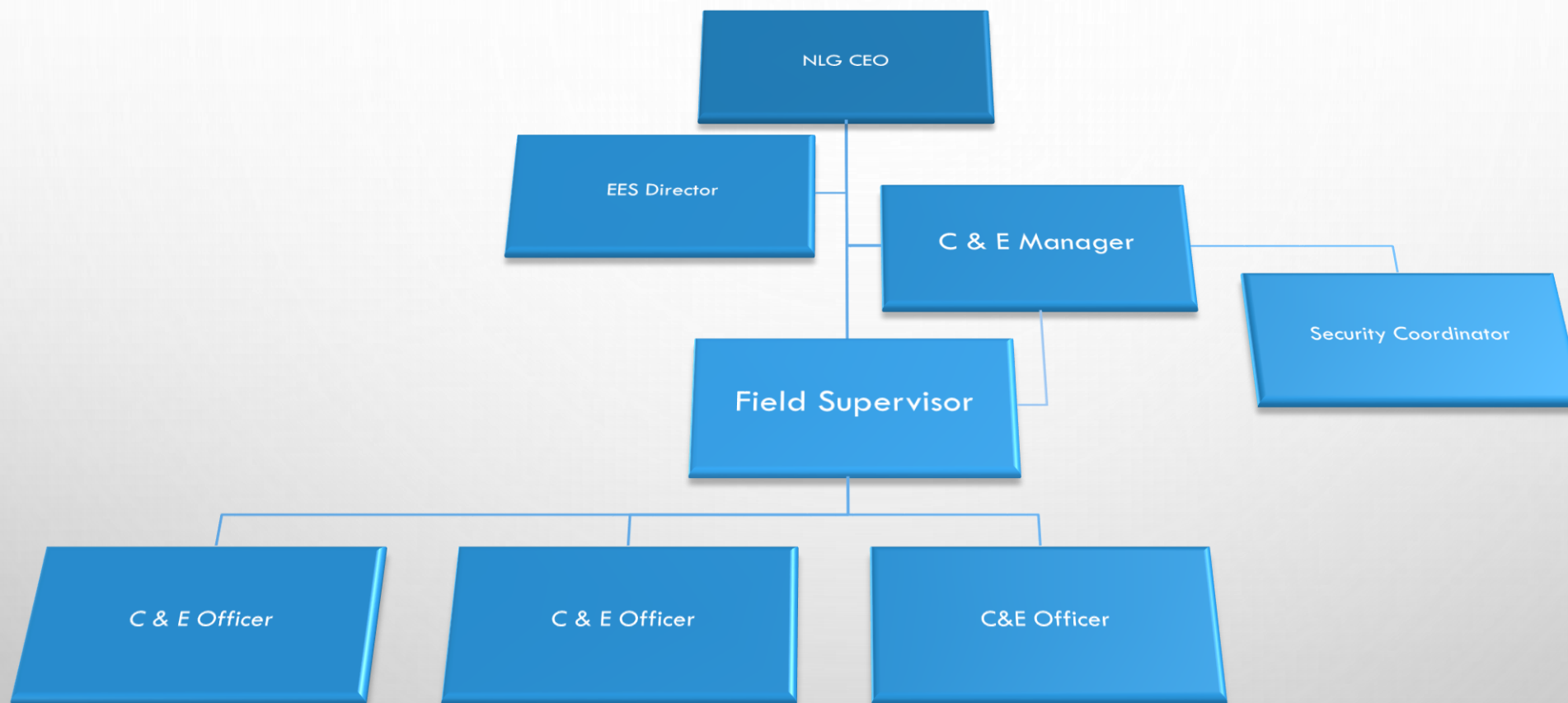
The **Nass Area** covers almost 27,000 square kilometers. About 8% of this area is Nisga'a Lands which roughly correspond to what people think of as the Nass. This area is patrolled by NLG C&E by land, water and air.

C & E OFFICERS HAVE A 3 MONTH PROBATIONARY PERIOD TO COMPLETE BEFORE JIBC TRAINING BEGINS. MOST OF THEIR TIME IS SPENT STUDYING NISGA'A TREATY LEGISLATION, REGULATIONS AND ACTS.



WHEN A C&E OFFICER HAS COMPLETED THE PROBATIONARY PERIOD HE/SHE ATTENDS JIBC TO COMPLETE THE LAW ENFORCEMENTS- INVESTIGATIVE ENFORCEMENT SKILLS AND PROCESSES. AFTERWARDS THEY ARE ON 1 YEAR OBSERVE, RECORD & REPORT.

Public Safety in our communities is a priority. Sometimes we have visitors who come and visit and overstay their welcome.

WILDLIFE REGULATIONS

ILLEGAL HUNTING & TRAPPING ON NISGA'A LANDS.

C&E Officers are on patrol checking areas.

- Designated species permits, Moose Goat and Grizzly.
- Illegal hunting

C&E officers patrol and respond to reports of illegal activities:

- Sales of fish
- Transporting without a permit
- Fishing during a closed period
- Sales of wildlife harvests
- Illegal Trade with Non-Aboriginal
- Undersized crab, cockles, clams



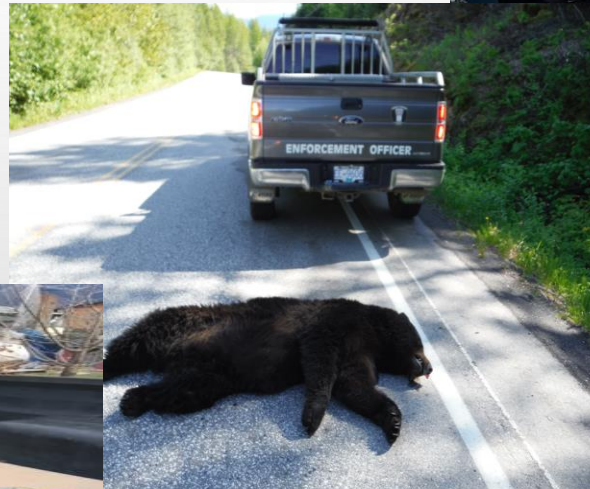
INVESTIGATIONS INCLUDE THE DUMPING AND WASTING OF RESOURCES.

Unfortunately it is common to find dump sites along the highway, landings and in tributaries close to the highway.




RESPONDING TO A MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENT INVOLVING WILDLIFE. IN MOST CASES WILDLIFE IS GIVEN TO A COMMUNITY OR AN UPCOMING FEAST.

It is C&E policy to give to the next community from who last received the Salvaged wildlife or to a carver depending on what type of wildlife. It may be given to a family who is holding a feast.
