JOB SUMMARY: The Nisga'a Wildlife Program presently focuses on the management of species (Moose, Mountain Goat, Grizzly Bear) designated under the Nisga'a Final Agreement. Guided by the Nisga'a Final Agreement, Nisga'a Fisheries and Wildlife Act, and associated federal/provincial legislation, policy, procedures and regulations, this position develops and implements wildlife and migratory bird species assessment and inventory projects to meet Nisga'a wildlife management objectives. The individual should be highly motivated and able to work independently and available to work odd hours and on the weekends. The successful applicant should be comfortable with working in an isolated environment. This position will be based in the picturesque community of New Aiyansh, BC

EDUCATION or OCCUPATIONAL CERTIFICATION:

- Minimum of a Bachelor's Degree in biological sciences or related field.
- Minimum of two years related experience which includes leading project design and delivery, analysis and reporting, and providing advice within a regulatory regime.
